All standing rigging made by Allied. List of lengths lost.

Spars made by Metalmast from 1968:

7-3/4 x 4-1/2, 0.140 wall extrusion with integral track

$$A = 2.63 \text{ in}^2, I_{x-x} = 16.48 \text{ in}^4, I_{y-y} = 7.11 \text{ in}^4$$

Extrusion no longer available. Would use 7-5/16 x 4-3/8.

Earlier spars made by Zephyr:

7-1/2 x 4, 0.150 wall extrusion with external track.

$$A = 2.64 \text{ in}^2, I_{x-x} = 15.04 \text{ in}^4, I_{y-y} = 5.66 \text{ in}^4$$

No full length extrusions available. (1) 38' length plus 33' extrusions available at \$29.50 per ft, anodized.
